The Honorable Elizabeth Holtzman will give the keynote address, "Bringing Nazi War Criminals in America to Justice." The event will include a candle-lighting ceremony, with Holocaust survivors escorted and introduced by Queens College students who have pledged to combat anti-Semitism.

Sinai Chapels is owned and operated by Michael Resnick and his family. Resnick will be recognized

at this year's event for his years of support to the Center for Jewish Studies.
